On June 6, 2017, pursuant to ORS 144.660, Governor Kate Brown transmitted a report to Senate President Courtney and Speaker Kotek outlining each reprieve, commutation, pardon, remission of penalty or forfeiture that her office processed pursuant to her constitutional authority under Article V, Section 14 of the Oregon Constitution since the previous report to the Legislative Assembly.

Governor Kate Brown has granted four pardons and has granted no reprieves, commutations, or remissions of penalty or forfeiture. Between March 3, 2016 and today, 17 applications for commutation of sentence, seven pardons, one reprieve and two remission of fines have been denied. There are 151 commutation applications pending. There are 81 pardons applications pending. Five reprieve applications are pending. There are four remission applications pending.
