**RE: Executive Summary of Executive Clemencies**

DATE: June 28, 2019

On June 28, 2019, pursuant to ORS 144.660, Governor Kate Brown transmitted a report to Senate President Courtney and Speaker Kotek outlining each reprieve, commutation, pardon, remission of penalty or forfeiture that her office processed pursuant to her constitutional authority under Article V, Section 14, of the Oregon Constitution, since the previous report to the Legislative Assembly.

Governor Kate Brown has granted six pardons and three conditional commutations. No reprieves or remissions of penalty or forfeiture have been granted. Between March 3, 2018 and today, 151 applications for commutation of sentence have been denied and one commutation applicant is deceased. There are 60 commutation applications pending. 77 pardon applications have been denied, 52 pardon applications are pending, and one pardon application was withdrawn. Two reprieve applications are pending. No remission applications are pending.
